Coach's Spotlight

This month we're placing Brett Gatehouse (Coach) and Ben Andrews (Assistant Coach), Ashy Redbacks Coach for Colts (Red), two very well credentialed players and coaches under the spotlight.

What do you love about coaching?

Brett – Having the responsibility of teaching people and helping people develop.

Ben - Seeing players develop and improve throughout the year. Watching a player grow confidence in themselves is the most rewarding thing about coaching.

Who has been the most inspiring coach you have had and why?

Brett – Erwin Leyden. He was able to get the absolute best out of every single player he coached. I don't think anyone ever under performed with him.

Ben – It's a tie. My first coach at Waverley Blues who taught me how to kick, as well as the importance of being able to kick with both feet, and my current coach at St Mary's Salesian, Jess Sinclair. Jess sets a high standard of training and puts a strong focus on pushing us to train at our best each week. He also encourages a strong team first mentality.

What have been the best words of advice a coach has ever given you?

Brett – One superstar playing for himself will never beat 18 mates playing for each other. **Ben** – Football is played between the ears. If you go out on the field with the right mentality to want to win the ball at every contest, to make every tackle and to make the most out of every opportunity you get on the field, then you will be successful.

Which AFL coach do you most admire?

Brett – Al Clarkson. He was perceived as just an angry little man when he first got the job at Hawthorn, but he moulded a side together that will probably go down as the greatest team ever, and evolved the game in no way any coach has before. He is a genius!

Ben – Alastair Clarkson. His ability to adapt his game plan each year to continually break down the defences of teams like Sydney, Fremantle and West Coast is extremely admirable.

What qualities do you think a successful coach needs to have?

Brett – A good communicator, an ability to teach, be firm with what they believe and someone that enjoys what they do.

Ben - Communication skills. If you can clearly convey a strong message and remain consistent with it, then players will listen and respond accordingly.

What are you most looking forward to about coaching the Ashy Colts (Red) team this season?

Brett - Watching a group of young blokes learn and develop in front me, and hopefully helping them to a finals series.

Ben - I'm really excited to see young players continue to learn and develop as young footballers. There are a lot of talented young kids at Ashy and I'm looking forward to having a successful year with the group.
